

English

This term, children will explore and learn the corresponding skills to write a letter and a portal story.

Teach reading sessions will allow children to develop their reading fluency and comprehension skills such as: retrieval, inference, predicting and summarising.

Children will be moving on to a new bridge to spelling scheme to further support them with their spelling.

Maths

This half term, children will be finishing their unit on perimeter before moving onto looking at fractions. We will explore equivalent and improper fractions as well as mixed numbers.

Additionally, children will be completing weekly arithmetic papers and daily Mastering Number sessions to improve children's fluency and recall of times tables.

History

In history, the children will be exploring the causes and treatments for the Great Plague and the impact that the Great Fire of London had on London.

Science

In science, we will continue looking at animals but specifically at the digestive system and how it works, in addition to the different types and functions of teeth. The children will also learn how to keep teeth healthy.

DT

Children will learn how to create lever and linkage mechanisms to create a moving picture card.

Computing

The children will be looking at how to develop a website as well as having a refresh on online safety.

PSHE

Children will look at how to be their best selves by thinking about who they are, what is important to them and how they should conduct themselves.

Music

Throughout this half term, the children will be developing their singing abilities and techniques.
