

English

This term, children will continue to develop their narrative writing skills to complete their Portal stories. As we move through the term, children will learn to write their own persuasive brochure and finally develop their knowledge of playscripts and performance through Shakespearian literature.

Teach reading sessions will continue to be taught daily and will allow all children to develop their reading fluency and reading comprehension skills such as: retrieval, inference, predicting and summarising.

Children will be continuing to develop their spelling through Little Wandle and progressing into the fluency stages which will recap and consolidate their understanding of various spelling

Art

Children will learn about embroidery and needle work. Children will learn about the craft of decorating fabric or other materials using a needle to apply thread or yarn. This is a practice within art that has developed over millennia.

Computing

The children will become Web Designers. In addition to learning about online safety, children will learn about different software and apps used to design their own webpages.

Maths

This half term, children will complete their understanding of fractions then progress onto decimals, including recognising decimals to one decimal place, comparing and ordering decimal numbers and multiplying and dividing decimals by 10.

Additionally, children will be completing weekly arithmetic papers which will improve the fluency of their use of the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). Finally, year 4 will continue to receive the new Mastering Number program which is specifically designed to improve children's fluency and recall of times tables.

PSHE

This term, we will be discussing and learning about how our bodies change as we grow through the different stages of life. Additionally, we will learn about safe and unsafe secrets linked to the stages of life.

Geography

Children will learn about mapping London's changes over time. The children will explore, through digital technologies, the physical geographic changes, the land use and will develop a more in-depth understanding of why places change. The children will learn about the buildings that make up London's skyline and explore why it is ever changing.

Spanish

We will be recapping basic greetings, numbers and asking simple questions about each other.

Science

Children will learn about whether natural disasters can be good for nature. They will learn about what natural disasters are and their impact on all life in the surrounding area.
